Do You Know About

Overdrive? Zinio? Hoopla?

Overdrive is the site that is used for e-books. You can access it through the library's website. An e-book can be downloaded to e-readers after ordering and receiving a message that it is available for checking out.

Zinio is a program that offers magazines on computers and/or tablets. It is accessible through our website or a Zinio app. The first time of use you will need to set up an account. Once the account is set up you are able to see the available magazines and check them out to read on your tablet or computer. (less magazines to recycle!)

Hoopla is a site similar to Netflix but also offers e-books, audio books and movies for children and/or adults. Again, it is accessed through our website or a Hoopla app. There is a limit of three movies per month but all free with a library card!
